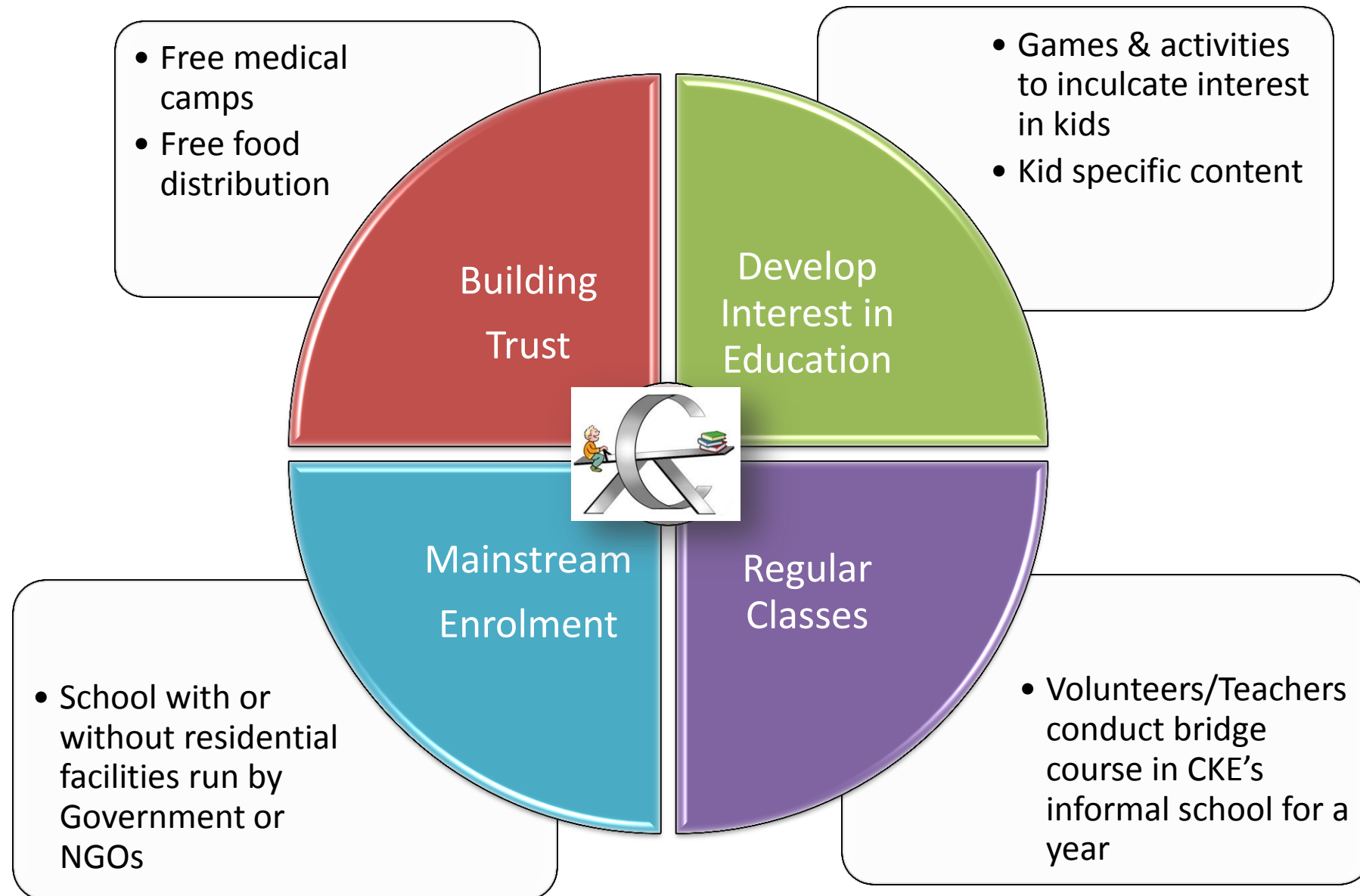
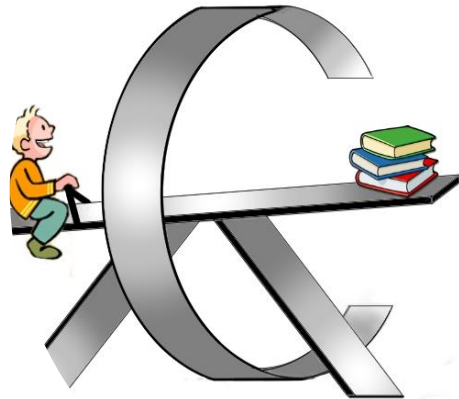


# Primary focus – Identify school dropouts and implement below workflow

Educational support \_ Government Schools

- Computer classes were taken in two government schools during 2017-2018
- Supporting 10<sup>th</sup> standard students of Aliya Government School for public exams

- Platform for Students [primarily for underprivileged] to express their talents in Academic, Sports & Cultural

Medical support for migrant construction site families

- 8 medical camps conducted since 2016 and more than 500 people got benefitted with free medical check ups and medicines

**2016-2019**

28 students completed bridging course under CKE & currently studying in various educational institutions across Hyderabad.



**2019-2020**

20 students are currently in CKE's bridging program. Post covid-19 pandemic, students will be joined in mainstream schools.



**Sustainability**

In 3 years, 37 students have been joined in mainstream schools. 9 students did not continue & became dropout again. CKE is continuing to work with them to ensure they receive their basic rights
